CLASS NOTICE ORDER

AND NOW, this 12th day of April, 2022, it is hereby ORDERED as follows:

1. Pursuant to this Court’s December 13, 2021 Order, the Class is defined as follows: All current and former employees of Bayada Home Health Care, Inc. (“Bayada”) or (“Defendant”), who worked in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania from August 3, 2013 through the date of the final disposition of this action as hourly paid Home Health Care Nurses (“Class”).
2. Pursuant to Rule 1711 (a), every member of the Class is included unless, within 60 days of emailing of the Class Notice, the Class Member elects to exclude himself or herself from the Class.
3. The form of Class Notice proposed by Plaintiffs, with the agreement of Defendant, and attached as Exhibit A to Plaintiffs’ Motion for Approval of Proposed Notification Procedure and Proposed Class Notice is APPROVED.
4. The Court finds that dissemination of Notice by email and website notice is reasonably calculated to inform the members of the Class.


5. Within 15 days of the date of this Order, Defendant shall provide an updated list of Class member names and email addresses, including any updates available since the email addresses were provided in January 2019.

6. Within 30 days of the date of this Order, the Notice shall be sent by email to all Class Members' email addresses and Plaintiffs shall create a website with the notice and contact information where Class Members can get additional information about their rights.

7. Within 60 days of mailing of the Notice, Class Members who wish to be excluded from the Class should send the request to exclude to Class Counsel, as set forth on the Notice.
