**DEFENDANT'S MOTION FOR
EXTENSION OF TIME TO RESPOND
TO PLAINTIFFS' FOURTH REQUEST
FOR PRODUCTION OF DOCUMENTS
(REQUESTS 128-129)**

Pursuant to Rules 6(b) and 34(b) of the North Carolina Rules of Civil Procedure, Defendant City of Charlotte ("Defendant"), by and through undersigned counsel, hereby moves the Court for a 30-day extension of time by which to answer or otherwise respond to Plaintiffs' Fourth Request for Production of Documents (Requests 128-129) filed in the above-captioned matter.

Defendant shows unto the Court that it was served with Plaintiffs' Fourth Request for Production of Documents (Requests 128-129) on or about **Monday, August 2, 2021**. Accordingly, Defendant has thirty (30) days in which to respond to the Plaintiffs' Fourth Request for Production of Documents (Requests 128-129). Thus, computing time under N.C. R. Civ.
