ORDER

AND NOW, this 12th day of September, 2025, upon consideration of the Plaintiffs' Motion for Conditional Certification and to Facilitate Notice to Potential FLSA Collective, filed August 22, 2025, *see* ECF No. 28, and Plaintiffs' Reply in Support of that motion, filed September 11, 2025, *see* ECF No. 32, **IT IS ORDERED THAT:**

1. Plaintiffs' Motion for Conditional Certification and to Facilitate Notice to Potential FLSA Collective, ECF No. 28, is hereby **GRANTED** as unopposed.¹
2. Plaintiffs are authorized to issue notice of this action to all current or former non-exempt hourly employees of Defendant during any workweek within the applicable statutes of limitations for the FLSA, dating back to March 19, 2022.
3. Defendant **shall provide** Plaintiffs' counsel within **fourteen (14) days** of this Order, the full name, last known home address, last known personal email address, last known mobile number, and dates of employment for all current and former employees who worked on prevailing wage projects for Defendant since March 19, 2022.

¹ Defendant's time to respond to the Motion, ECF No. 28, expired on September 8, 2025. As of the date of this order, Defendant has not filed a response to the Motion, nor anything to indicate either consent or opposition thereto.

4. Plaintiffs are authorized to issue notice of this action in the form attached to their Motion as Exhibit A, and are authorized to use the Opt-In Form for those wishing to join this action in the form attached to their Motion as Exhibit B.

5. The Opt-In time period will be sixty (60) days from the date of mailing of the Notice.

6. Plaintiffs' counsel may send a reminder notice to recipients of the Notice thirty (30) days prior to the expiration of the Opt-In period.

7. The Notice of this action in the form attached to their Motion as Exhibit A, shall be prominently posted at the Defendants' job sites.
